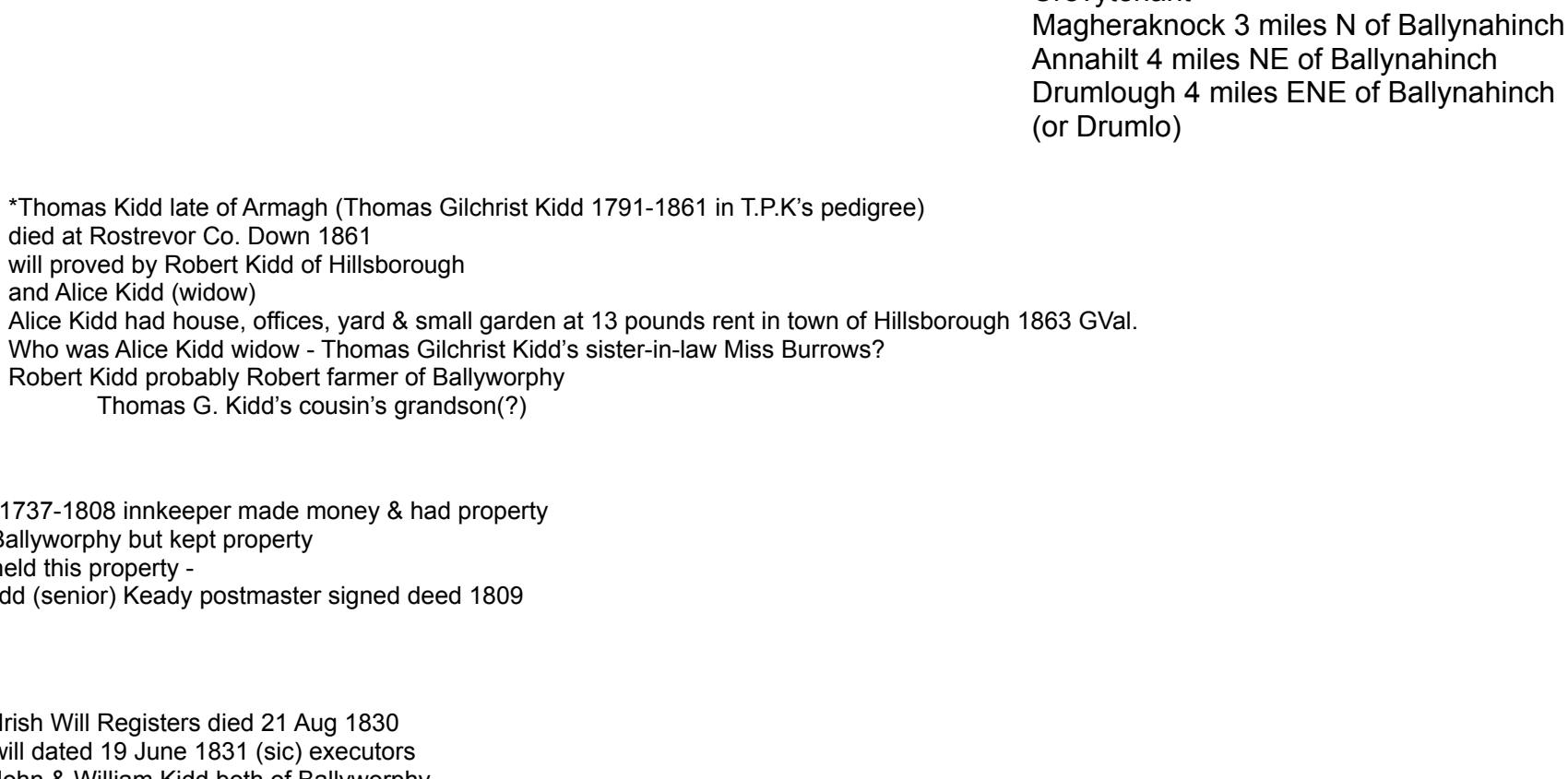
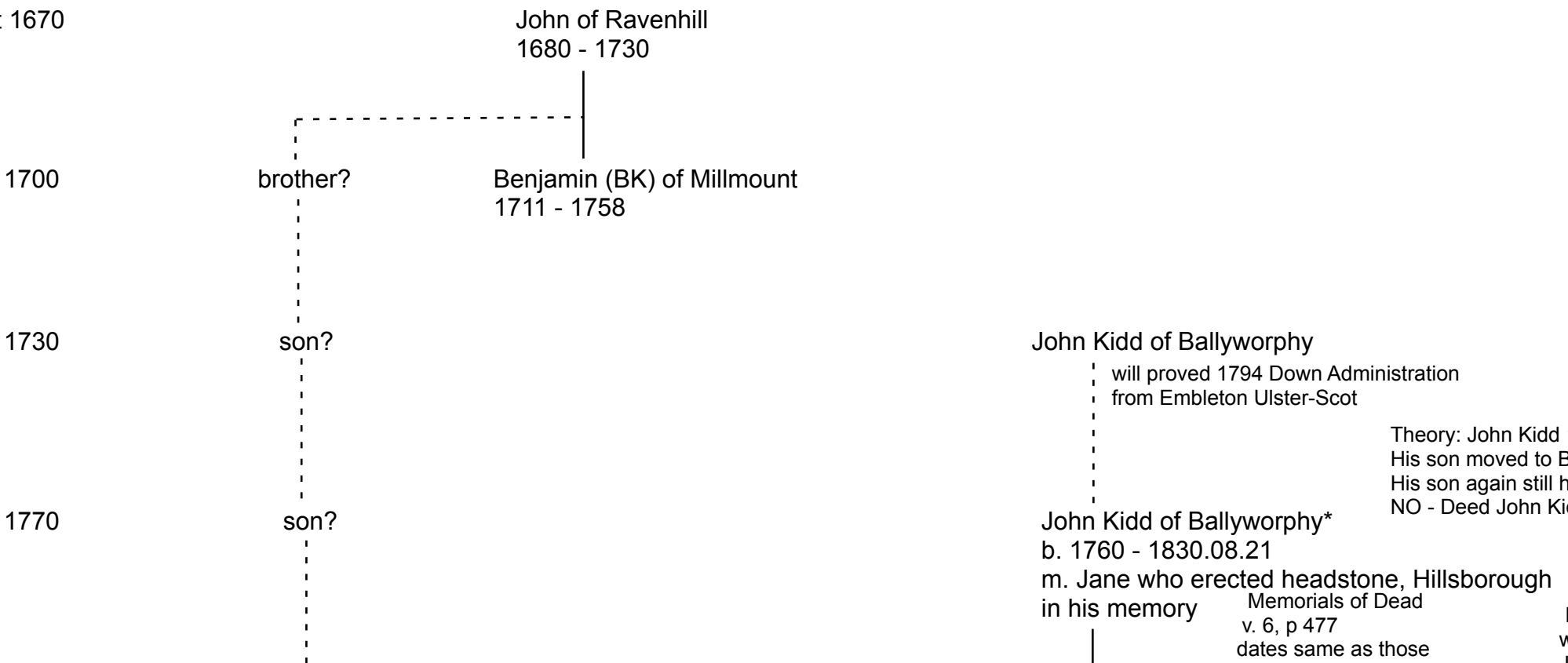
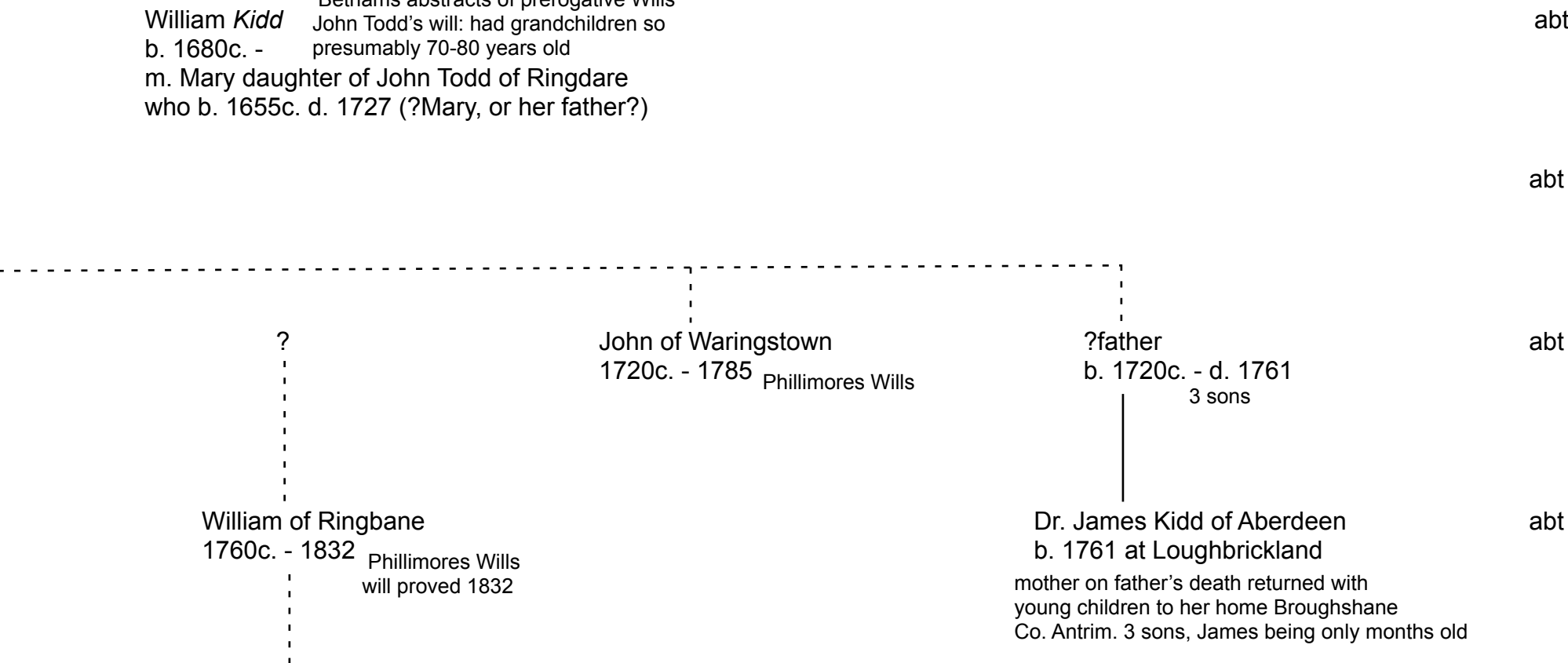
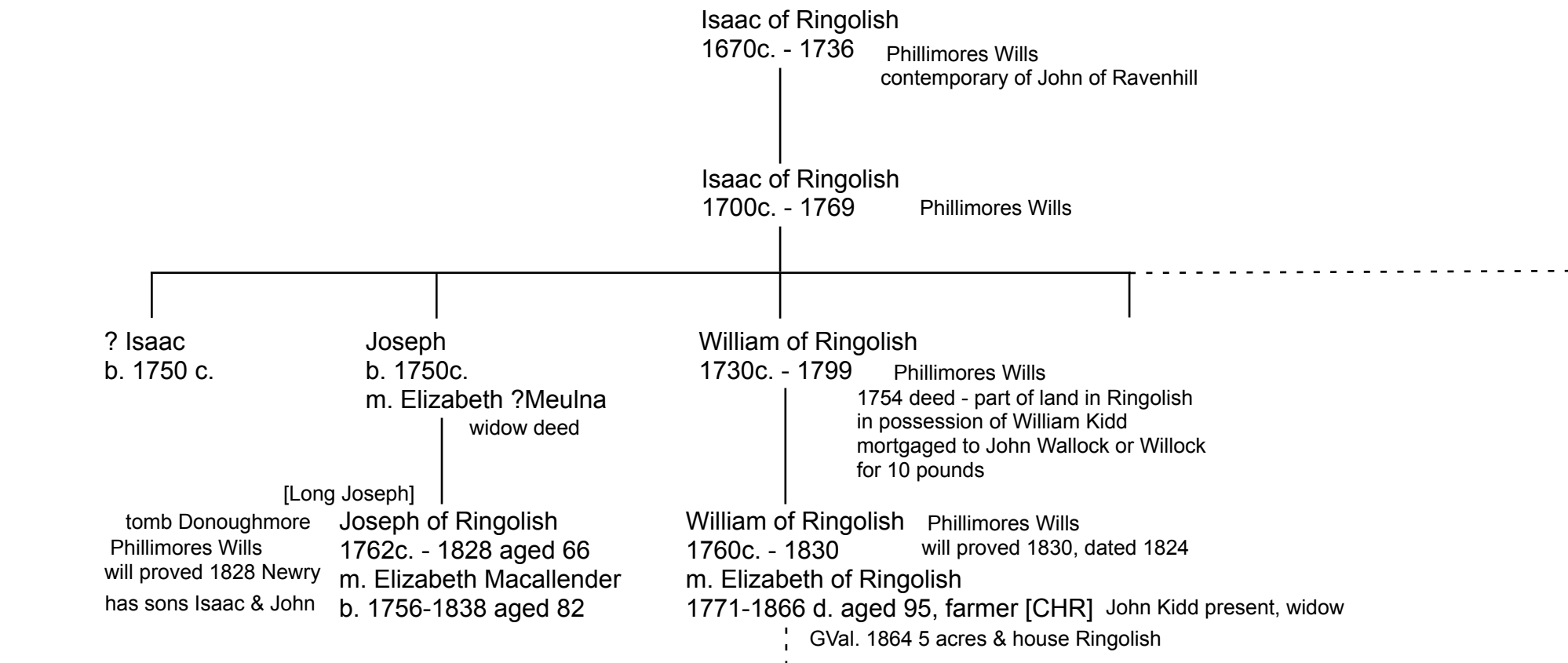
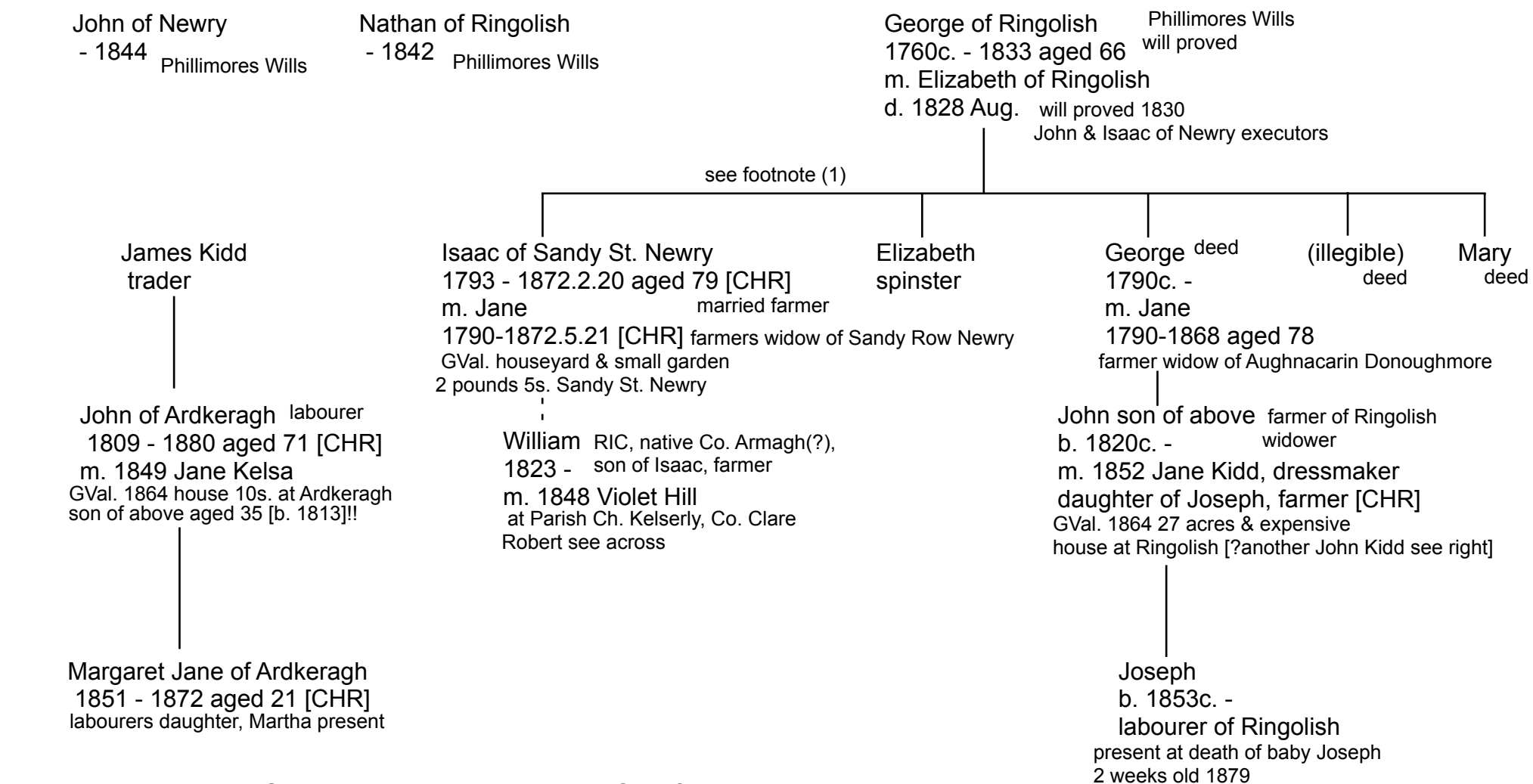


Ringolish Kidds chart - drawn by Franklin Kidd ~1960's from his own research findings

Theory: John Kidd 1737-1808 innkeeper made money & had property
 His son moved to Ballyworphy but kept property
 His son again still held this property -
 NO - Deed John Kidd (senior) Keady postmaster signed deed 1809

Irish Will Registers died 21 Aug 1830
 will dated 19 June 1831 (sic) executors
 John & William Kidd both of Ballyworphy
